

Puppet Playtime

Description & Requirements

- The Puppet Playtime can be 30 to 45 minutes in length.
- It is designed for children from preschool through the 3rd grade.
- Sound system if needed is provided.
- The school is required to provide one adult sized chair.
- Children can be seated on the floor. The performer sits on the same level. No stage is required.
- Puppet Playtime uses a "U" shaped seating plan.
 Youngest children are in the front but slightly to each side of the performer. Older children are in the center. Short children are seated in front and taller children are seated in the back.
- Set up and tear down requires 20 minutes each.
- Puppet Playtime is frequently used for birthday party entertainment.
